- -Coastal area management with particular focus on the waterfront, sea uses, protected areas, fishery resources and tourism.
- Tourism with particular attention to sustainable tourism, to the 'new tourism' the 'third age' and root tourism and the phenomenon of Overtourism.

Scientific Activity

The scientific production includes about 100 publications including books, manuals, articles and various contributions, numerous reviews, bibliographical reports, notes and newsletters resulting from collaboration with leading geographic journals, collaborations on systematic geography volumes for university and high school teaching, as well as various editorships.

Scientific activity can be divided into four periods: the one that corresponds to the three-year period of overtime as a researcher (1990-1993), the following one (1994-2004) in which he matured an extensive production, but at the same time oriented towards specific fields of study of human geography paying attention to continuously update his research on the basis of the evolution of Italian and foreign scientific thought and (from 2005 to 2015) that as associate professor of geography in which he developed a particular interest in socio-cultural and intercultural geography (see work on migration and aspects of inter-culturality) and latterly in gender geography, focusing his research both on the social effects of environmental issues (environmental policy) as well as on targeted investigations into the status of women in sub-Saharan African countries (gender geography), and again in the area of social geography and tourism, research was undertaken in the area of third age tourism. The fourth period (from 2015 to the present) corresponds to the assumption of service as a full professor and the main research interests still focus on intercultural geography (in particular with regard to food, UNESCO cultural landscapes, migration processes), the geography of tourism (from a critical perspective) the applied research privileges Sub-Saharan Africa.
